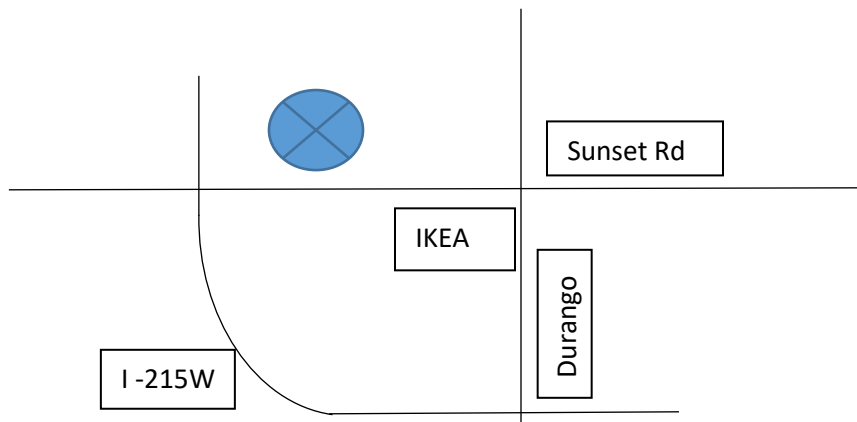

We are pleased that you are going to have your surgery at Ear, Nose and Throat Surgery Center. We want you to have a safe and pleasant experience and would suggest the following for you:

- Pre-registration is required. You will receive a text or an email 2-3 weeks before surgery to login to the Patient Portal. Completing this process ahead of time will facilitate the admitting process.
- Your copay, if any, will be collected upfront the day of surgery. You will receive a text or an email regarding your quote. Full payment is due the day of surgery.
- The following will bill separately to you or your insurance company: The Anesthesiologist, The Surgeon, The Surgery Center and The Pathologist (who examines any specimens taken during surgery).
- Please bring a picture ID, insurance card, or other required documents (scan CD, copies of any labs, xrays, or clearance requested by your doctor).
- The Doctor's office scheduler is responsible for informing you what time to report to the center.
- Anesthesia may call you the night before to go over your medical history, if they don't call you, they will speak to you prior to your procedure.
- Nursing staff will call you the day prior to your procedure day to give further instructions. (If your procedure falls on a Tuesday, pre-op phone call will be done Friday afternoon the week prior)
- Do NOT eat or drink after midnight unless otherwise instructed by your anesthesiologist.
- If you take any medication for your heart, blood pressure or seizure medications normally in the morning, you may take it with a small sip of water as soon as you wake up.
- Female patients may be asked to provide Urine for pre-op testing on the day of surgery. Please DO NOT use the restroom without notifying the front desk staff and pre-op nurse.
- Wear comfortable clothing, if your having a sinus procedure, please wear a button down or zip up shirt, to avoid the surgical area. If you have any body piercing or jewelry please remove them prior to your arrival to the center.
- Bathing is highly encouraged the night prior to surgery. All jewelry and piercings should be removed prior to arriving at the surgery center. Metal may cause injury during procedures.
- Please make sure you have a responsible adult to take you home after surgery, you are not permitted to drive.

- Adult patient may have one person in preop/recovery area. Pediatric patients may have both parents, no siblings.
- (for MINORS only) A parent or guardian must remain in the facility while the child is at the center.
- Children may wear their pajamas, we will change them into a surgical gown for the procedure. They may bring a comfort item such as a blanket or a toy.
